



# Merry Month Of May

## Game Board



Students will use this game board to review vocabulary learned from the ***Student Readers***, if you are using this game with the May Day Celebrations thematic unit. Each student playing in the group will contribute the vocabulary cards they made as playing card. When it's a player's turn, he will take a card, read the word and then tell the meaning. The meaning is written on the back side of the cards. If his answer is correct he will take his turn.

You can also use this game board with any set of flashcards, or lists of questions and answers that you want the children to practice. You may have them read a passage from the science or social studies text and state the main idea. You may use the science cards provided with this unit. You can let the students think of good ways to play to learn. Put this board at any center for the Month of May and use it for any type of skill practice.

The game board comes in two sizes. Use this file if you are printing on letter sized cover stock. Use file 4b if you are printing on ledger sized cover stock.

### Preparation

1. Run off the game materials on 8.5x11 white construction paper or cover stock. If you are using the letter sized game board, trim the inside space on one of the game board section, and tape or glue it together on the back. Make as many boards as you need for your class size.
2. Laminate all game pieces and cut them out.
